The New Pasco County Clerk Seal

In the past, Pasco County Clerks have used the State of Florida Seal for Pasco County documents. It was my desire to make the Clerk Seal more personalized and unique for Pasco County. The new seal was developed with help from your Deputy Clerks and each part of the seal has true Pasco County significance.

- **Colors** – Red, White, & Blue are the predominant colors of the seal, signifying our patriotism, commitment, and inclusion in the United States.
- **Seal Interior** – There are five items in the Interior of the Seal: the Country/State Motto, the year of Pasco County's beginning, the Historic Courthouse, an Ink Well and Scroll, and a Financial Symbol.
 - **"In God We Trust"** – In the center of the seal, the Country's motto and the State's motto is proudly displayed.
 - **1887** - The year Pasco County was divided out of Hernando County is proudly displayed at the bottom of the Seal Interior. It is set like a footnote and reminder of both the youth and richness of Pasco County's history.
 - **Court System** - A drawing of the Historic Courthouse located in Dade City, the County Seat, tops the middle of the seal, representing both the history of Pasco County and the Clerk's role in the justice system.
 - **Recorder of Deeds** - In the bottom left of the interior of the seal, an ink well & scroll are included to represent the recording duties of the Clerk & Comptroller.
 - **Comptroller** – The financial symbol displayed in the bottom right of the seal represents the Comptroller functions of the Clerk & Comptroller. The symbol can also be found on the dollar bill and contains the all-seeing eye and triangular glory, signifying the Clerk & Comptroller watching over the County's finances.
- **Seal Exterior** - Two circles surround the new Seal, one blue and one red.
 - **Blue Circle** – The inside circle displays the office name, "Clerk of Circuit Court & County Comptroller" and "Pasco County." County Comptroller was added to the office name to signify that Pasco County's Clerk also has the responsibilities of the County's Custodian of Funds. In some Counties, the financial duties are performed outside of the Clerk's Office. In most cases, the title will be shortened to Clerk & Comptroller.
 - **Red Circle** – The exterior circle displays "Sixth Judicial Circuit," which is shared with Pinellas County, and "State of Florida." Six stars are displayed within this circle, representing the six municipalities in Pasco County: Dade City, New Port Richey, Port Richey, San Antonio, St. Leo, and Zephyrhills.
