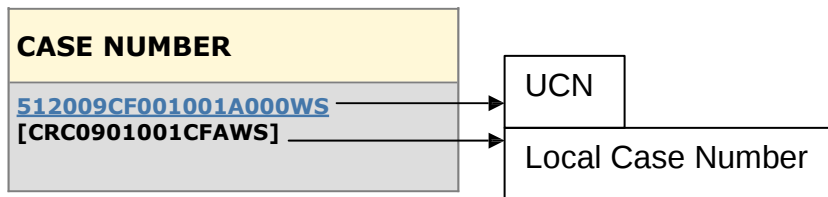

UNIFORM CASE NUMBERS

Effective January 1, 2003, the Clerk's Office started using the Florida Supreme Court's mandated Uniform Case Number (UCN). This is a number that contains twenty characters in length. The first fourteen characters are formatted uniformly throughout the state. The next four characters of the UCN are optional fields for the county to use. The last two characters designate the courthouse location where the case is assigned. With Criminal, Criminal Traffic, and Ordinance cases, the local case number will also appear in parenthesis under the UCN.



The description below illustrates the format of the UCN.

Court Type Designators

CA = Circuit Civil
DR = Domestic Relations/Family
CP = Probate
GA = Guardianship
MH = Mental Health
CC = County Civil
SC = Small Claims
AP = Appeal from County Court

CF = Felony
MM = Misdemeanor
CJ = Delinquency (confidential case type)
DP = Dependency (confidential case type)
CT = Criminal Traffic
MO = Municipal Ordinance
CO = County Ordinance
TR = Traffic Infraction
IN = Non-Criminal Infraction
